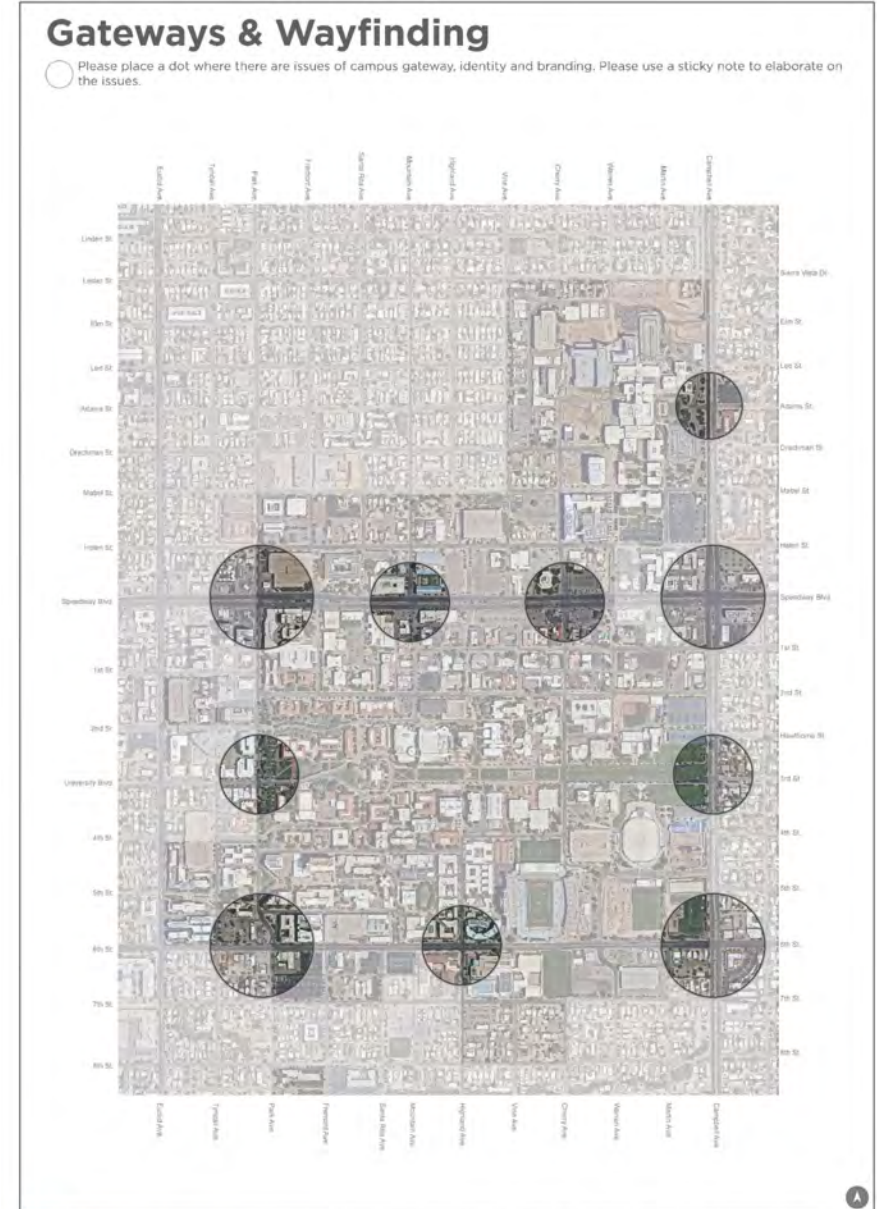
- Need improvement at intersections

Key Takeaways:

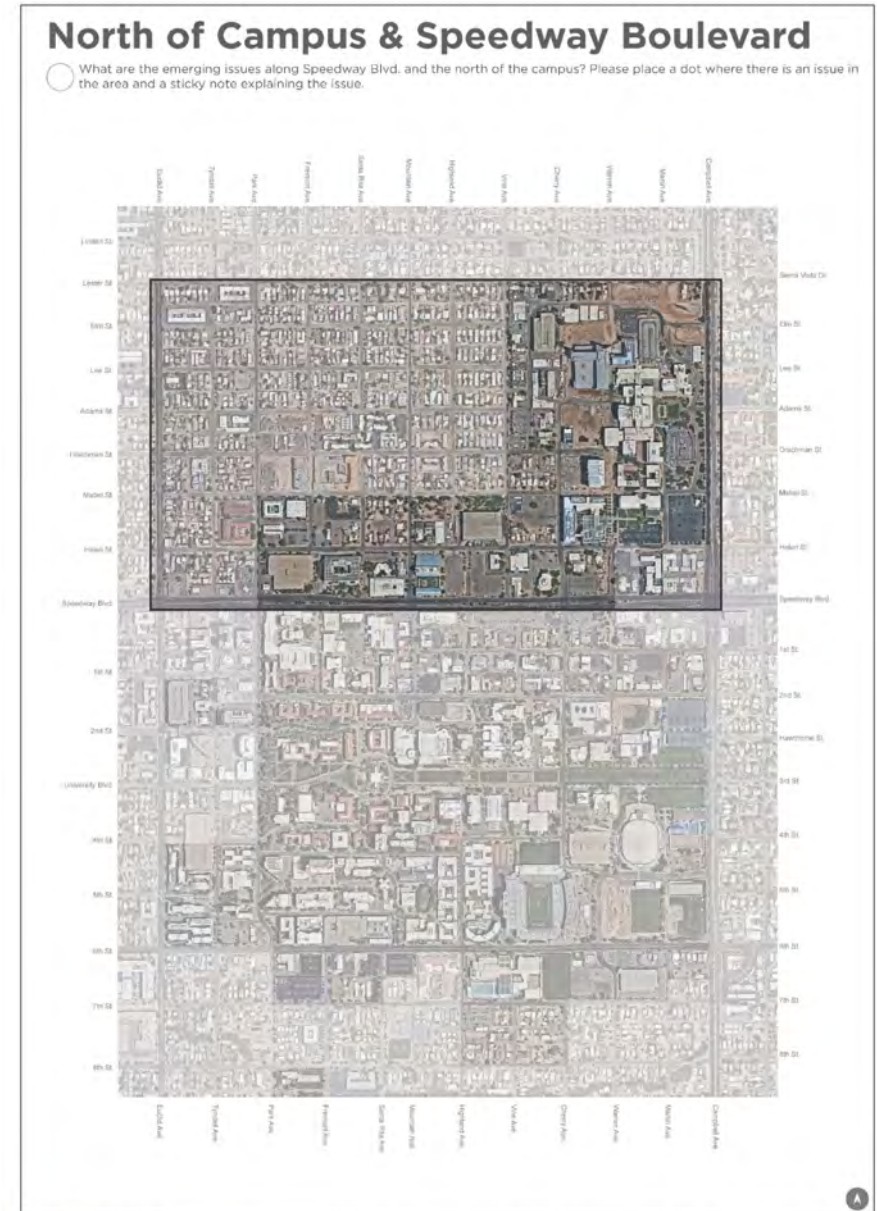
- Need to create a better sense of place

- Add living spaces on campus.

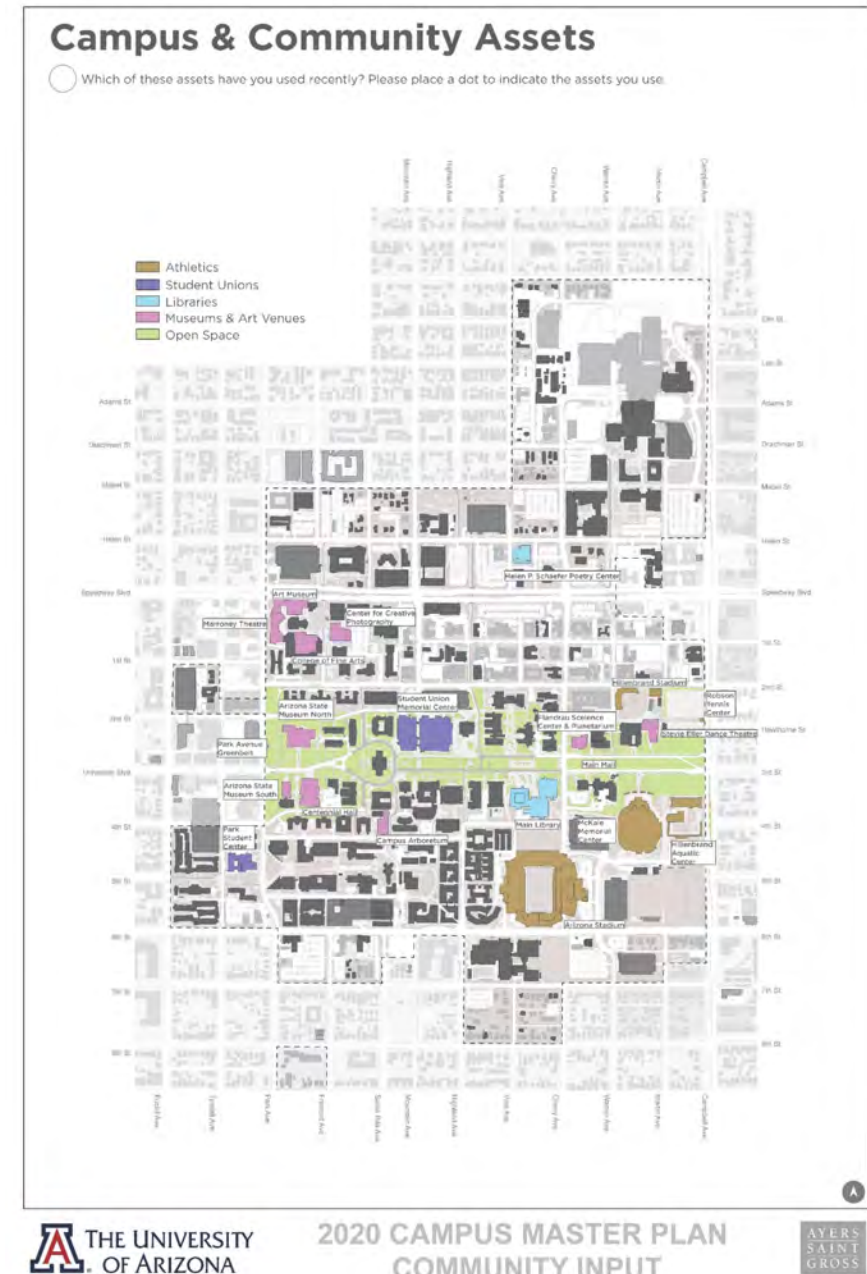

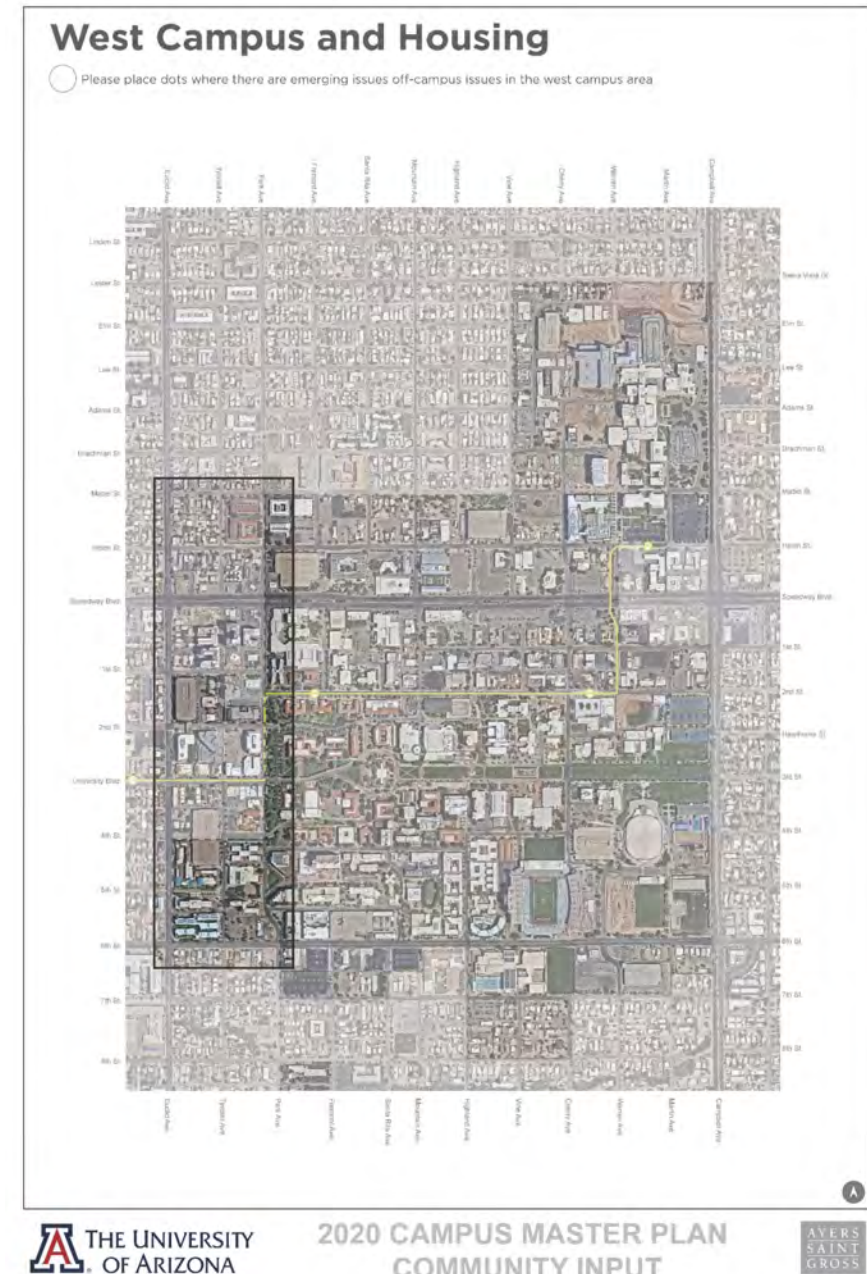

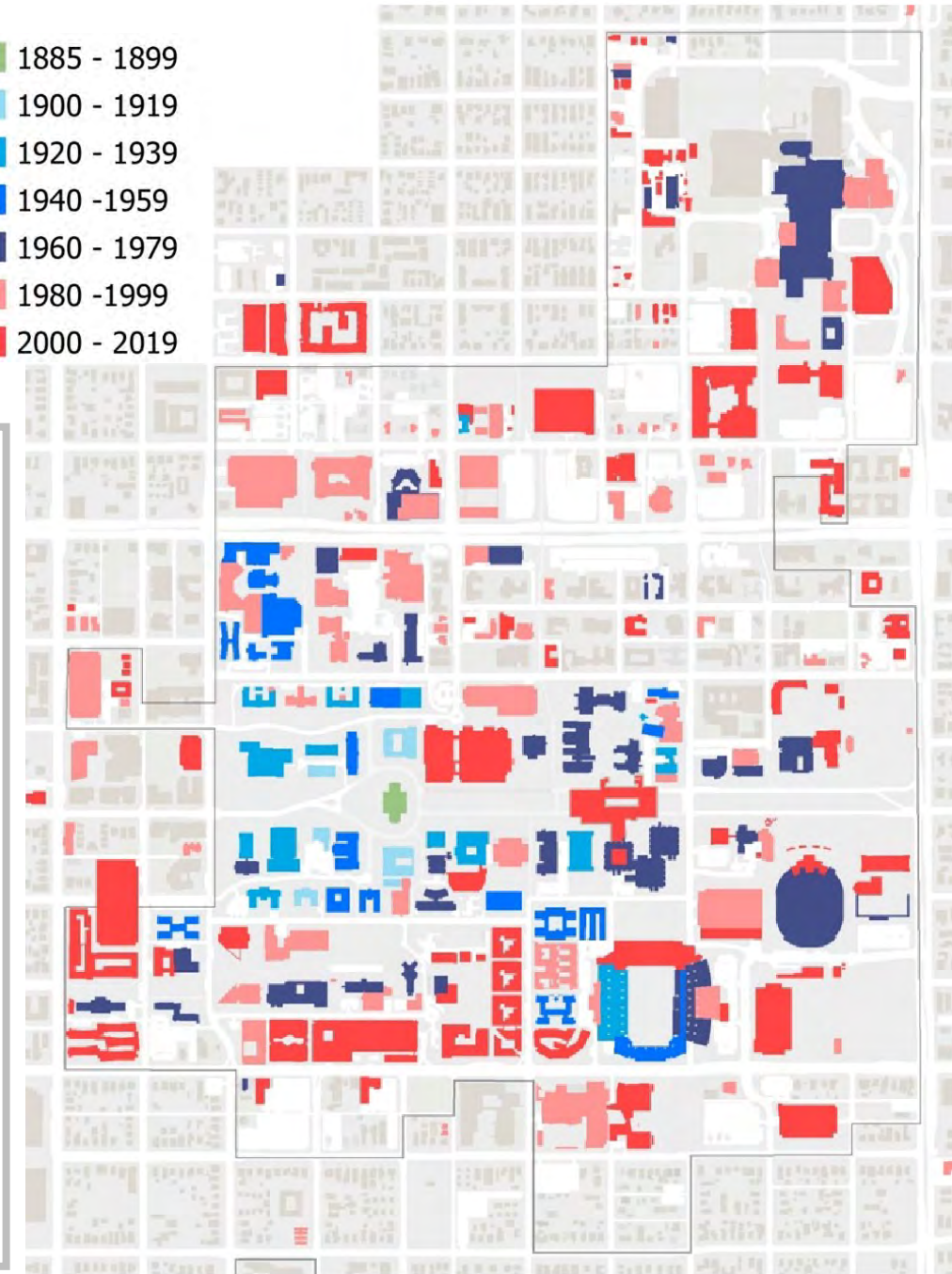
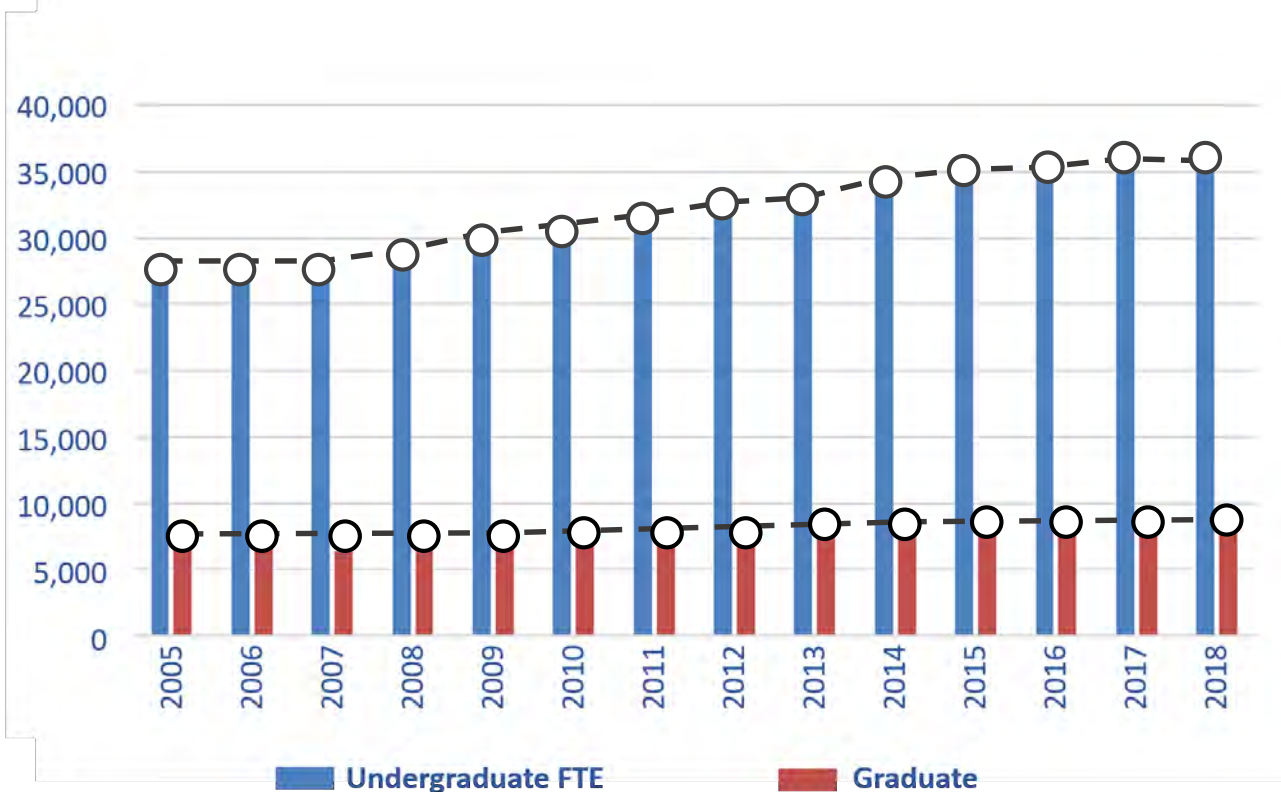

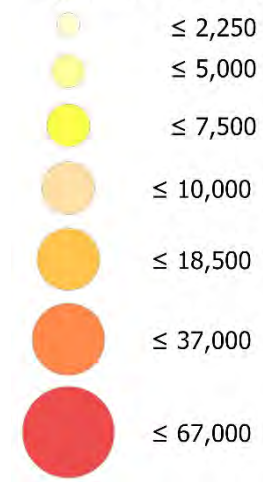

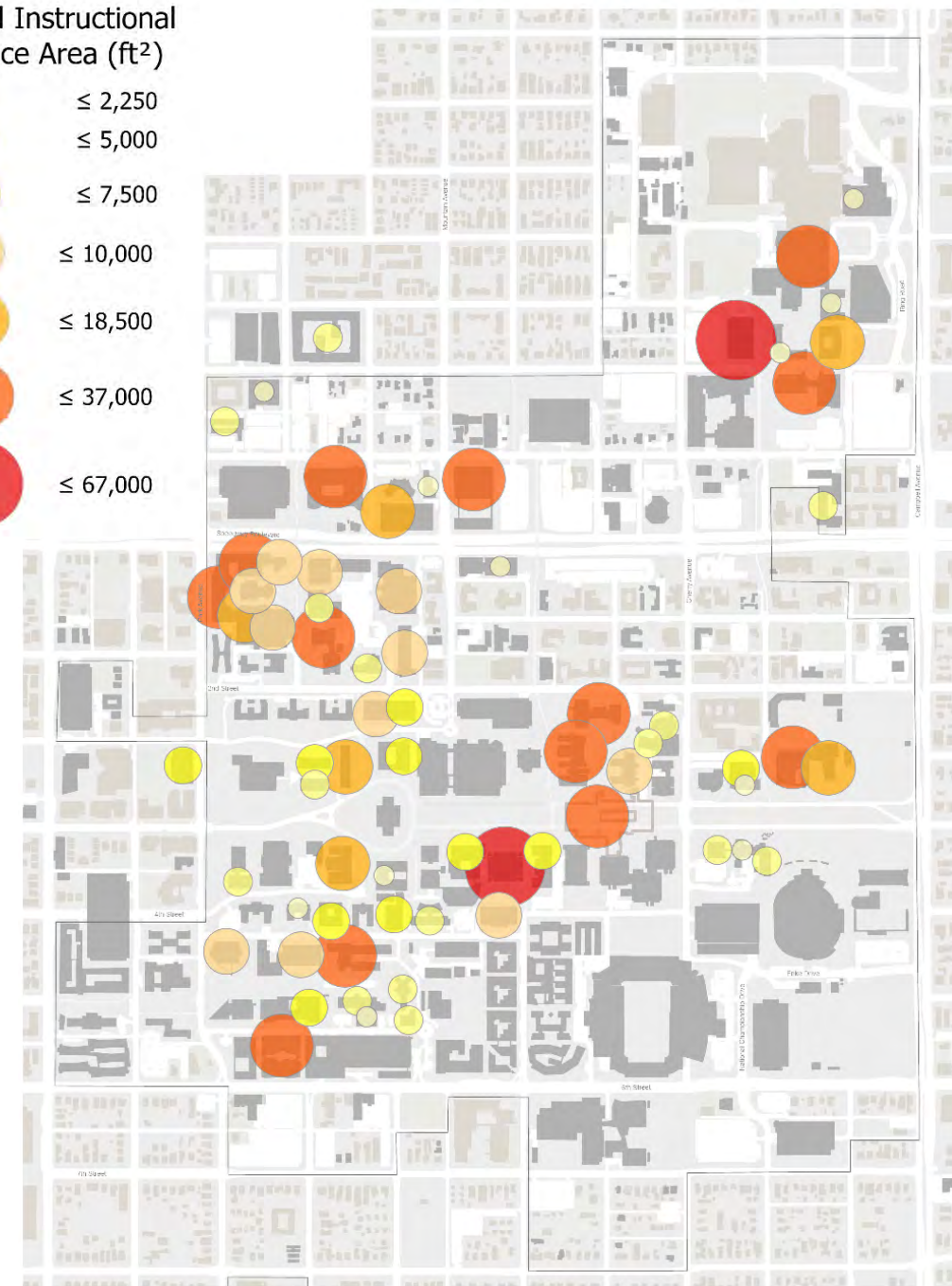


Flexible and Adaptable Instruction and Pedagogy

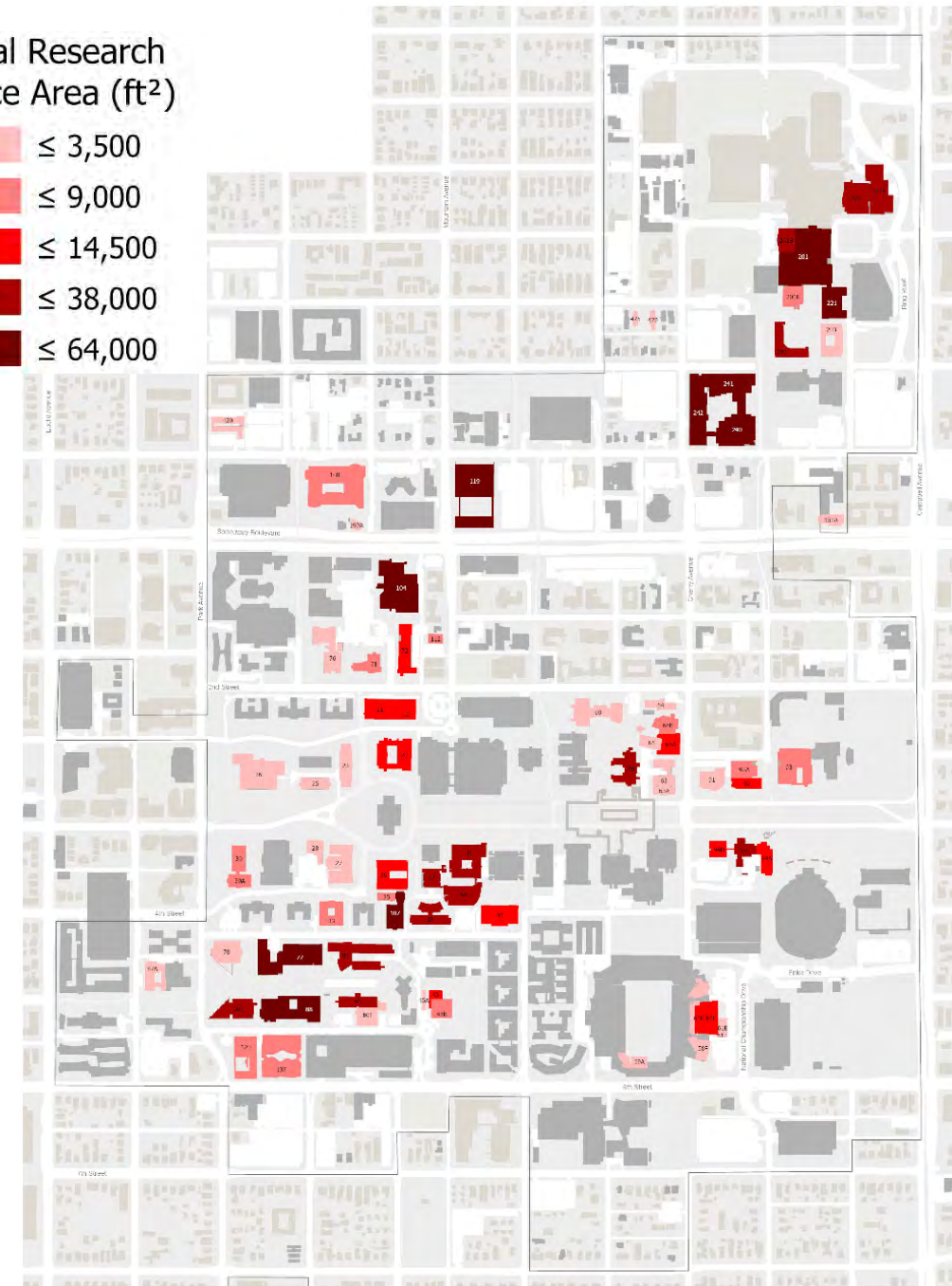
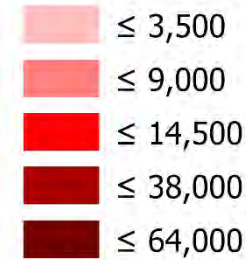
